Team Composition

A Recurve team comprising of up to four (4) men and four (4) women;

A Compound team comprising of up to four (4) men and four (4) women;

As outlined in the AA rules, who are eligible to compete at the National Archery Championships in the given year; are selected and named as the Archery New South Wales (ANSW) Team. Team Members must agree to shoot the appropriate distances for the National Championships to qualify for selection.

Events

While the primary event for the ANSW team is to compete in the National Archery Championships, the team may also be called to compete in other scheduled or one off events.

Team members must agree to:

- Be and remain financial members of Archery NSW while on the team
- Compete in both Target & Field at the National Championships
- Shoot the bow type for the event they gained selection in
- Comply with all current Tournament & Shooting Rules & Team Guidelines
- Register an intention to be selected
- Wear Archery NSW Uniform at all times
- Comply with Team Management directives at the event.
- Participate in ANSW team development day activities unless excused.
- Support the objectives of ANSW.

ANSW State Team Selection:

To be eligible to be considered for selection in a State Team, a member must have competed, during the season of selection in at least:

- four (4) ANSW tournaments, three of which must be the State Target, Field and short course Championships, (*unless tournaments commitments at a higher level prevent them from doing so. If so these scores will be used to rank the applicant*).
- one or more ANSW regional and/or interstate tournament
- two or more ANSW interclub tournaments
- Archers applying for state team selection must submit scores from the State Championships in Short Course, Target and Field.
- Applications must be received by the advertised cut-off date.

Selection period

- ANSW selection period will start from the end of the National Championships in the previous year to 30 days prior to the National Championships in that year; or the end of the State championships whichever is the shorter time preceding the National Championships in that year.

Team to be selected:

1. From the received applications, positions one to four will be allocated to the top four (4) placed archers based on their aggregate scores from the State Short course, State Target & State Field competitions
2. Where an archer withdraws from the team or event, the substitute will be called from;
 - a. Those archers who submitted an application,
 - b. The next placed archer in order of total aggregate scores.
 - i. e. A vacancy from the placing positions will be replaced by the next highest placed archer who is not already on the team.
 - c. All existing team members will hold their existing position,
3. Resolution of Ties for the fourth place team member will be based from whom has the greater attendance at ANSW events during the selection period.

Funding Eligibility:

- Archers must be selected and compete as a State Team member at the National Championships.

Financial Support

- Any ANSW funds to be allocated for team support is dependent on current ANSW Budgets
- Will include the reimbursement of entry fees of events relevant to the National Teams event
- Other financial support may be available to assist in offsetting accommodation and travel costs to the event particularly for those team members that take advantage of any organised "team accommodation"
- Additional Funding
Opportunity may exist for performance reward funding, Performance awards may be available to team members that win the Teams event at the National Championships

Definition

"ANSW and AA sanctioned events" **means** WA or AA registered Tournaments or Events registered with AA hosted by AA, ANSW or a club & published on ANSW Calendar and includes QRE's.

Season of selection means: The time from the previous National Championships to the month prior to the upcoming National Championships.

Disqualification:

ANSW may at its complete discretion remove any archer's application from team selection if in the opinion of the Coaching Administrator & ANSW board, an archer's behaviour or conduct is not worthy of team representation. Archers have a right of appeal through the Grievance policy.

Dispute Resolution and Appeals:

Disputes and appeals will be handled by the ANSW CoM in line with the ANSW Grievance policy.

Team Captains

ANSW Coaching Administrator will appoint one Captain from among those who qualify for the team.

- ANSW invites those archers to express their interest in holding a Captain position to submit an expression of interest with their team application form to the Coaching administrator
- The team Captain will support all ANSW archers including the team.
